 - Due to new Florida legislation, you have to leave your name and address in order for code enforcement to investigate (the only exception to this rule is in case someone is dumping items or liquids into lakes and storm drains).
- City of Lakeland -Stacey Smith-
 - Currently the city of Lakeland has identified 70,000 trees that the city currently maintains. Trees help reduce electricity costs by the canopy cooling infrastructures. Trees intercept rainfall and help negate stormwater runoff.
 - Only businesses and multi-family units are regulated by tree ordinances.
 - Please Call 811 before planting a tree to locate utility lines; to ensure trees are not planted in the wrong location.
 - Residents get 4 free bulk yard waste pick-up. Please call 863-834-8773
