- Call to order 6:30pm (Tonya Rogers)
- Introductions
- LPD report by Angie Ellis:
 - 2 burglaries, 1 abandoned car, and 3 suspicious persons
 - Please make sure to call every time you see a suspicious person. 2 unconfirmed 911 calls. Please stay on the line if you call 911 by accident. Also, National Night Out is coming soon. It will be at Naylor Park on Lake Hunter Dr.
- Officer Halstead in the neighborhood liaison unit:
 - He said that soliciting without a permit is an offense. They can solicit from 9 to 8 during daylight savings. If persons are soliciting without a permit, you may call the police.
- Code Enforcement - Joie Brownlow -Code Enforcement Officer
 - He introduced Adam Gomez who will be representing him whenever he is not available to come.
 - In the last month there were 72 cases opened in the Dixieland area.
 - Joie answered questions regarding current open cases.
- Jason - Century Homes Project-
 - He started it in the summer of 2020. The project has a benefactor (Michael McGuire) that pays for all of the plaques. The project checks when houses were actually built. There are 80 verified Century Homes in the Dixieland Neighborhood.
 - Jason offers to put the plaques on the homes if the homeowner has difficulties.
- Karen Moore: Karen describes how to recognize when someone is having an opioid overdose. She explained how to use a product Nalaxone Nasal Spray that helps save lives when a person is having an overdose from opioids. This product does not hurt, but can help save the life of an opioid addict. You may obtain the product for free at a crisis center such as Peace River.
